



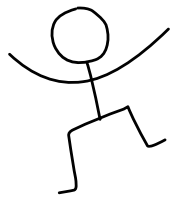
## 01. Encourage a love of reading and build confidence.

- Let them choose what to read (comics, graphic novels, joke books). It all counts!
- Choose books that relate to their interests
- Listen to audiobooks together
- Keep reading time low-pressure and brief (even 10-minutes is great!)

## Support at school helps. For example:



- Use a finger or ruler to keep place when reading
- Pre-teach key words to help understand new texts
- Don't ask them to read aloud in front of the class
- Literacy programs
- Small group or 1:1 support
- Use technology to help
